



CENTRAL VALLEY BY THE NUMBERS

- The region's population is projected to nearly double from 6.8 million in 2010 to 12.8 million in 2060.
- The top four counties in agriculture sales in the United States are in the Central Valley.
- Education and health services provide the largest number of jobs in the region, followed by trade, transportation, and utilities.
- The Central Valley is home to 21 giant oil fields that have produced over one billion barrels of oil each, making it California's most productive region.

Together, BizFed Central Valley members – large and small – from all sectors of our 37 cities and five counties will use our collective voices to amplify our political influence.
